
## How to find us



- Fight your way through the building works to leave the airport & take the lane for Malaga just after exiting a roundabout. This is the left hand of two lanes. Go over the motorway & immediately follow the motorway access road round to the right, joining the carriageway Eastbound towards Malaga.
- 2 The motorway approaching this junction has three lanes, get into the lane 3rd from the centre, which eventually leads off onto the A7 motorway, signed Motril, etc. This is a tricky junction – the signs are a bit misleading, so don't be tempted to turn off prematurely – stay in the nearside lane, 3rd from the centre & exit towards Motril.

On joining the A7, keep following the Motril or Almeria signs on the A7 motorway. After a few km, you will need to move over to the lane 2nd from the centre to avoid being led off to Sevilla & Cordoba; keep following the signs to Motril or Almeria – it's 20 to 30 minutes to the next turn off.

3 Note the kilometer markers – you are looking for kilometre 272 – junction 272 for Casabermeja (& Velez Malaga). At the exit roundabout under the motorway (Jn 272) head inland on the A356 (North) signed sometimes Casabermeja, sometimes Colmenar.

Straight over two roundabouts, passing Repsol then Cepsa garages on your right.

- 4 Note the kilometer markers as you head north; just a few meters after marker km 39 on your right, turn right onto the road signed Canillas de Acietuno, Sedella & Salares. 500 metres to the T junction, follow the road left.
- 5 After a couple of kilometers, look out for a sharp right turn towards Canillas de Acietuno, Sedella & Salares. Easily spotted is the yellow RUTA DEL MUDEJA sign at this junction.

The mountain road now climbs towards Canillas; there is a roundabout at the edge of Canillas - bypass the town by keeping right. Follow the signs to Sedella & Salares.

On arriving at Sedella (approx 15-20mins) keep on the road to Salares. Passing by Sedella, pass the Cemeterio on your left – only about 1km to go now!

6 So far, so good; you are not lost (yet). You will pass a crude sign "Se Alquila, Casa Rural" (house for rent) on your right, (unless someone has stolen it). About 100m past this sign, take a right onto the dirt track. If you have taken the correct track, after 30 meter a glimpse over your left shoulder should reveal the white village of Salares in the valley below.

Proceed down the track – through the cutting (just like Cornwall) – then down a steep bit – wind turbine ahead & to the left, complete with stable block & white sand menage & maybe even a lady with a nice horse. Look for the gates with an Estrella Azul painted tile hung on the gatepost with blue wire. The gate's not locked – just lift the padlock. Beer's in the fridge..
